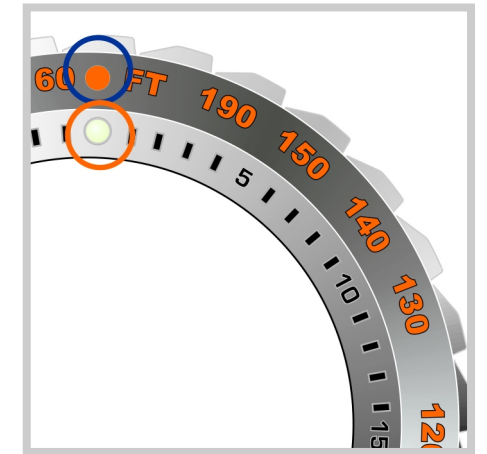


BEZEL OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

OWNERS MANUAL

The dive bezel of the DOXA SUB diver watch series consists of an **outer ring** indicates the dive depth for a no decompression dive, an **inner ring** indicating the corresponding dive time and decent marker.



EXAMPLE:

For a 100ft/30 metres dive your no-decompression limit would be 25 minutes according to your dive table bezel.

A.

At the beginning of your decent rotate the bezel lining up the decent marker of the bezel with the minute hand.

B.

Assuming that the deepest position of your dive is at 100ft depth start ascending once the minute hand reaches the corresponding 100ft mark on the outer ring of the bezel.

The corresponding mark on the inner bezel will tell you that your no-decompression limit in this case was 25 minutes.
